



Bible Study

Paul and John in Dialogue: A Bible study with William Picard & Diana Beecher

The Book of John was the focus for the Monday Morning Bible Study and Tuesday Women's Bible Study this past fall. During that study, there were interesting connections made to Paul's New Testament letters. Therefore, starting January 14th and 15th, our Monday and Tuesday classes will explore three major themes important for both Paul and John: Dark and Light, The Holy Spirit, and the meaning of the Cross.

Paul's writings were the earliest New Testament writings. John's Gospel was the last of the four gospels to be developed. Was John influenced by Paul? How are their ideas similar and how do they differ? What does it all mean for us? The New Year is a good time to join one of these studies. You be able to engage in fabulous, thoughtful conversation and you will also be engaging in a wonderful fellowship opportunity with your church peers.




