Our 8:00am and 10:00am services will be held under the tent, and I am sure you won't want to miss the wonderful music and flowers this year.

I hope you plan to experience the resurrection of our in-person services during Holy Week – a rebirth of sorts for our faith community after a long season of Lent and pandemic. Virtual services will continue for those who are away or not ready to rejoin in-person.




### From the Trustees




